HLTAIDO14 <b>Provide Advanced First Aid</b>	<ul> <li>This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide an advanced first aid response, including management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance. In completing this unit, students will learn how to successfully:</li> <li>Respond to an emergency situation,</li> <li>Apply appropriate first aid procedures,</li> <li>Coordinate first aid activities until arrival of medical assistance,</li> <li>Communicate details of the incident, and</li> <li>Evaluate the incident and own performance.</li> </ul>

In completing these unit, students will learn how to successfully:</li> <li>Respond to an emergency situation,</li> <li>Perform CPR procedures,</li> <li>Apply appropriate first aid procedures,</li> <li>Communicate details of the incident, and</li> <li>Evaluate the incident and own performance</li> </ul>

HLTAIDO15 Provide advanced resuscitation and oxygen therapy	<ul> <li>This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to use specialised equipment in the provision of resuscitation in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines. In completing this unit, students will learn how to successfully:</li> <li>Respond to an emergency situation,</li> <li>Perform advanced resuscitation,</li> <li>Communicate details of the incident, and</li> <li>Evaluate the incident and own performance.</li> </ul>
PUAEMEOO5 <b>Provide Pain Management</b>	This unit of competency involves the skills and knowledge required to administer restricted analgesics to provide pain management as part of a medically supervised first responder organisation. It includes identifying the need for analgesia; accessing, preparing and administering restricted pain relief such as analgesics and aspirin according to medically endorsed protocols; performing casualty handovers and completing analgesic use requirements. In completing this unit, students will learn how to successfully:

	• Access and prepare analgesic,
	• Administer analgesic,
	Perform casualty handover, and
	Complete analgesic use requirements
