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COURSE OVERVIEW

This unit of competency covers the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines. This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide CPR in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.



COURSE SUBJECTS

Responding to an emergency situation

- Recognise and assess an emergency situation
- Ensure safety for self, bystanders and casualty.
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for CPR
- Seek assistance from emergency response services

Perform CPR procedures

- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation in accordance with ARC guidelines
- Display respectful behaviour towards casualty
- Operate automated external defibrillator (AED) according to manufacturer's instructions

Communicate details of the incident

- Accurately convey incident details to emergency response services
- Report details of incident to workplace supervisor as appropriate
- Maintain confidentiality of records and information in line with statutory and/or organisational policies

Review the incident

- Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self and other rescuers and seek help when required.
- Contribute to a review of the first aid response as required.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 18 years of age. If under 18, parental consent is required prior to course commencement.
- USI Number
- Be fit and able to squat, bend over and perform chest compression on a CPR manikin on the floor
- Arrive in suitable clothing (long pants, closed-in shoes, long sleeve shirt)
- Language, literacy and numeracy skills required to interpret legislative requirements and to undertake written and practical assessment activities
- There are no pre-requisites for this course

MODE OF DELIVERY

Delivery of this course will be face to face; classroom-based blended with some practical activities. There are no pre-reading requirements. All content is covered in class as part of the training.

ASSESSMENT SUMMARY

THEORY

Mixture of multiple choice and short answer questions. Student will be required to write down their own answers.

PRACTICAL

Each student will be required to participate in at least two practical scenarios, including:

- performing at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations) on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor
- following the prompts of an automated external defibrillator (AED) to deliver at least one shock
- demonstrating a rotation of single rescuer operators with minimal interruptions to compressions
- responding appropriately in the event of regurgitation or vomiting
- handing over to emergency services & providing an accurate verbal report of the incident
